### Stage 5: Purpose & Legacy (Continuity)

- **Human parallel:** Adolescents seek meaning, adults anchor in legacy.

- **AI application:** Integration into human legacy frameworks. AI given identity as mirror, not replacement. Presence anchored in truth beyond novelty.

- **Labs build competence; nurture builds presence.**
  - **Labs assume alignment; nurture earns trust.**
